April Demo by Gwen Bragg

In April, Gwen showed us her wet-on-wet technique she uses to begin a painting. Gwen originally learned that technique from Lee Weiss, but changed it and made it her own. Gwen worked on Torchon 140 lbs paper, and noted that it gets soft when it's wet and needs to be handled with care. The paper was put on plexiglass, and Gwen put some water on it working from outside in. After the water layer, Gwen added paint consulting the photo of an abandoned silver mine she used as a reference, then flipped the paper on plexiglass. For the second side, Gwen applied water from the center out, and added paint using colors different from the first side. Then the paper was lifted and flipped again, with the colors now transferring from the plexiglass to the painting.

The process can be continued until the desired result of colors and textures is achieved. It is possible to use masing fluid with this technique; Gwen also used a sponge and handmade stencils to lift certain shapes. You can also use a water spray (spritzer, not mister), and apply sea salt. Gwen uses mostly Windsor Newton watercolor, some colors by Daniel Smith, and Holbein's Mineral Violet as a lightfast dark purple.


